My name is Connie.

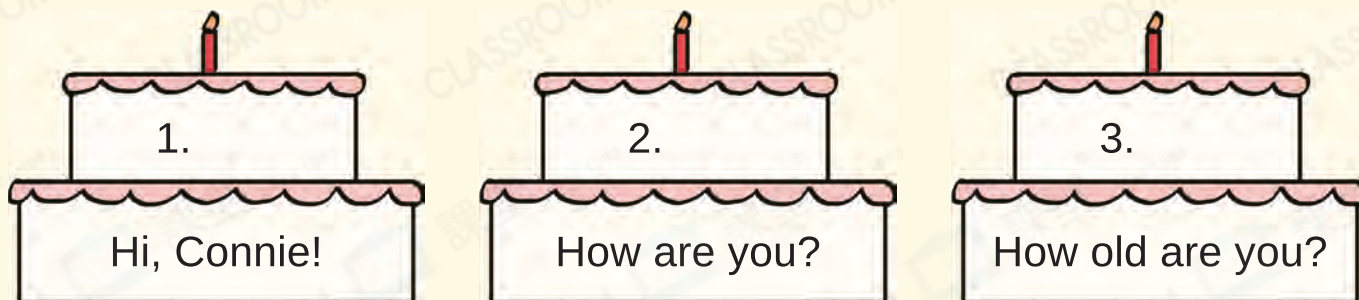
How old are you?
