Grammar Explained

- a) We use the modal verb **'must'** to talk about things that we have to do. We use **'must not / mustn't'** to talk about things that are wrong to do.

Students	must	listen to the teachers.
	must not / mustn't	draw on the walls.

- b) We use **imperatives** to give orders. We put the verbs at the beginning of imperative sentences.

Keep quiet	in the	library.
Sit still		hall.



Helpful Tips

- a) We don't change the form of **'must'** or the form of the verbs after **'must'**.
 ✗ She **mustn't talks** loudly. ✓ She **mustn't talk** loudly.
- b) We can also use **'Do not / Don't'** to tell people not to do something.
 e.g. **Don't eat** on the MTR.

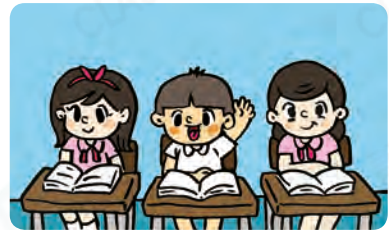
