Common Mistakes

(There is / There are)

We use 'There is' and 'There are' to show that something exists.

e.g. There is a rubbish bin in the classroom.

We use 'has' and 'have' to show that people own something. Never use 'there has' or 'there have' in English. They are incorrect.

e.g. Angel has three oranges in her backpack.
