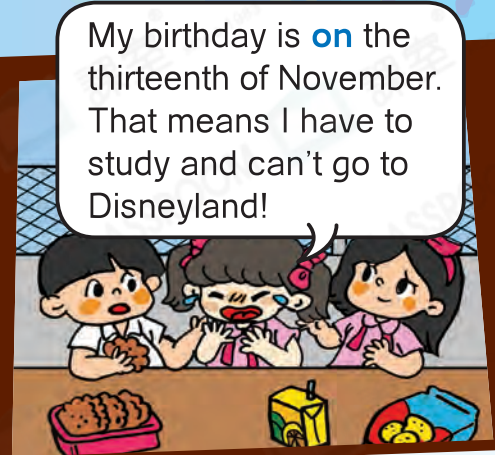

on a date

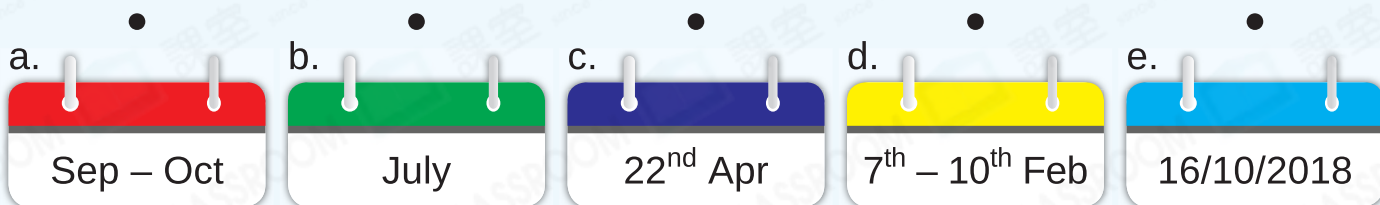
The school picnic is **on** the nineteenth of October.
