

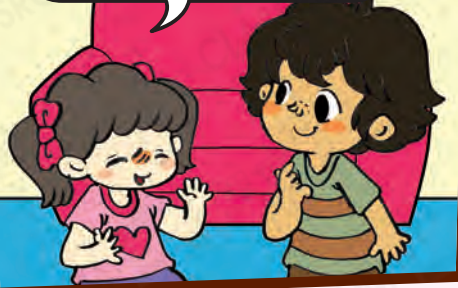

Grammar Explained

- a) We use the **simple future tense** to talk about things that we think will happen in the future. We use **'will'** with the base form of verbs to form sentences in the **simple future tense**.

Will	you	go	to the party	next week?
	Karen	visit	the zoo	soon?

Yes, I **will**.

No, I **will not / won't**.

Yes,	she will / she'll visit	the zoo	soon.
No,	she will not / won't visit		

- b) We can also use **'will'** to form 'wh-' questions and ask for specific information about things to do in the future.
