Common Mistakes

(be going to + Present Continuous Tense)

Do not mix up 'be going to' with the **present continuous tense**. We use 'be going to' to talk about future events.

e.g. I **am going to stay** at home this Sunday. (*a future event*)

We use the **present continuous tense** to talk about events that are happening at the moment of speaking.

e.g. It **is raining** so I **am staying** at home now. (*present events*)

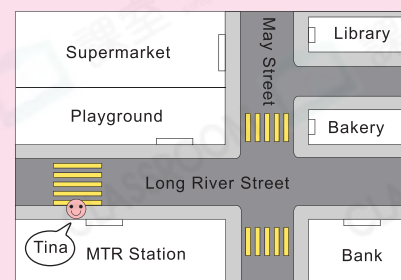
