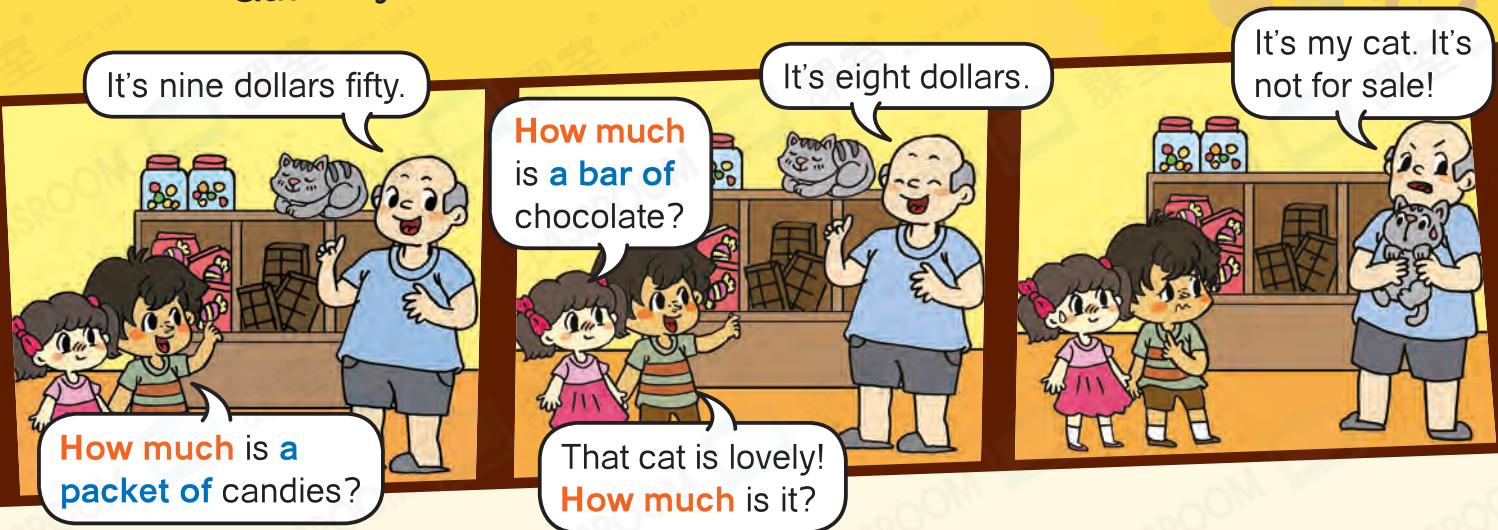

How much is **a bottle of** water?

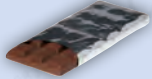
It's five dollars fifty.
