

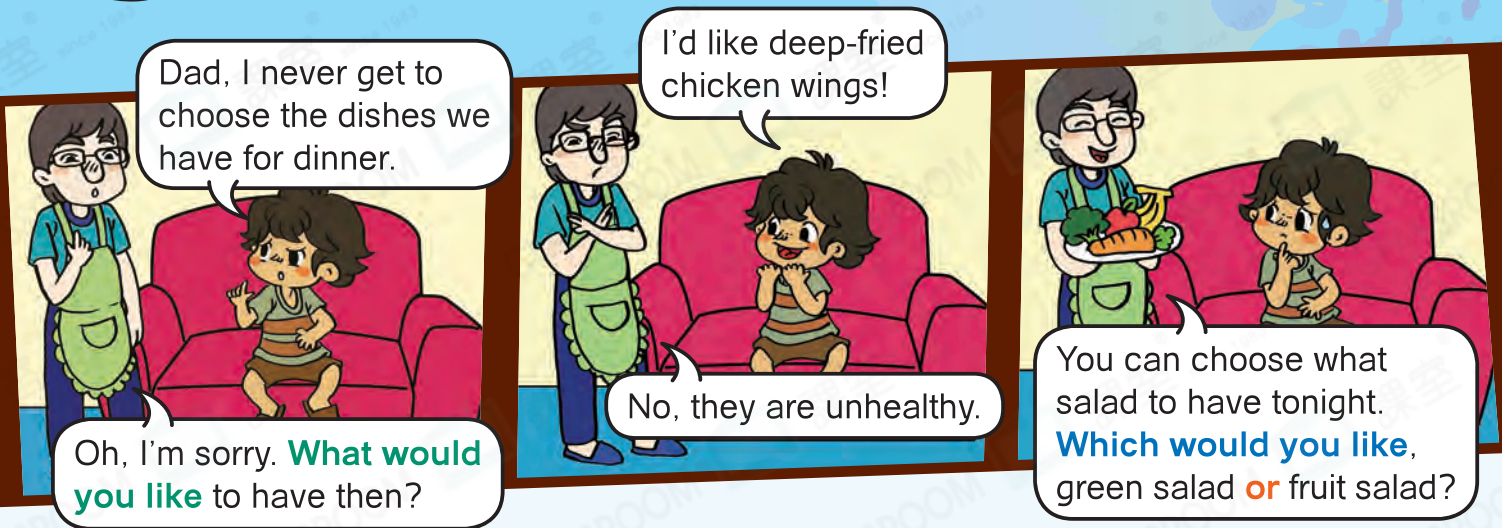

### Grammar Explained

- a) We use **'What would you like'** to ask people what they want politely. We use the question word **'what'** when there are many possible answers.

#### What would you like?

I would / I'd like	some curry.
	something spicy.

We would / We'd like	a chocolate pudding.
	mango salad.

- b) We can also use **'Which would you like'** to ask people what they want politely. We use the question word **'which'** when there is a limited number of choices to choose from. We use **'or'** to link the choices.

<b>Which would you like,</b>	chicken	<b>or</b>	fish?
	tea		coffee?

I'd / We'd like	chicken.
	tea.
