Alright. Sorry, Dad.



Grammar Explained

- a) We use the **present perfect tense** to talk about the present results of actions that happened in the past. We use 'has / have' + past participle to form the **present perfect tense**.

I	have done	my homework.
---	------------------	--------------

Connie	has lost	her purse.

- b) We use the adverb '**yet**' to form questions and negative sentences in the **present perfect tense**.

Have	you	eaten your breakfast	yet ?
-------------	-----	-----------------------------	--------------

Has	Cody	found his socks	
------------	------	------------------------	--

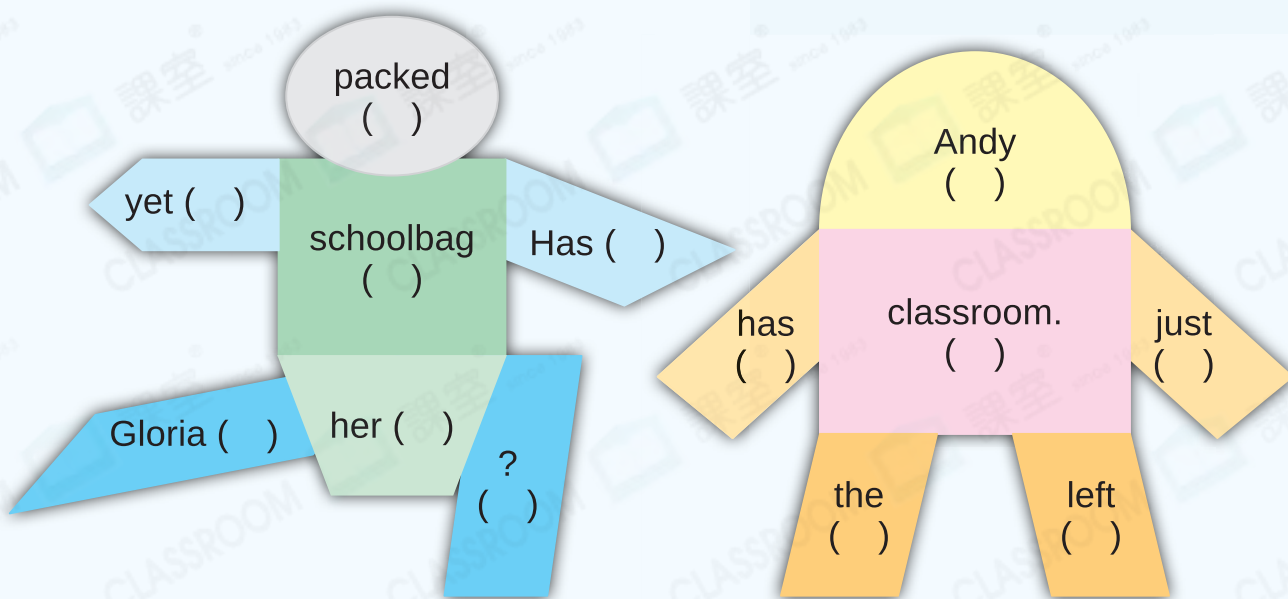
They	have not / haven't packed	their bags	yet.

- c) We use the adverbs '**already**' and '**just**' to form positive sentences in the **present perfect tense**.
