Grammar Explained

- a) We use the adverb **'ever'** in questions to ask if people have done something up to now. We use the adverb **'never'** to show that people have not done something before.

We may add 'before' at the end of the sentences to make the meaning clearer.

Have you **ever** been to Australia (before)?

Yes, I have.

No, I haven't.

Yes, I have been to Australia (before).

No, I have **never** been to Australia (before).

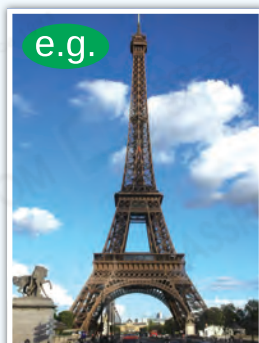
Sarah has **never** watched a film alone.

- b) We usually use **'How many times'** to ask questions in the present perfect tense. We use **'once'**, **'twice'** or **'(number) times'** to talk about the number of times people have done something up to now.

How many times has Sarah been to Ocean Park?

She has been there **once / twice / three times** to Ocean Park
