Common Mistakes

(Conditional Sentences)

We use **conditional sentences** to talk about actions or situations that will only happen under certain conditions. There are different types of conditional sentences and they carry different meanings.

If..., ...will... : things that are likely to happen in the future

e.g. If Samson **gets** sick, he **will see** the doctor.

If... were..., ...would... : things that are unlikely or impossible to happen

e.g. If Alice **were** a mermaid, she **would live** in the sea.
