Common Mistakes

(Passive Voice + Present Perfect Tense)

We use 'be' + past participle to form sentences in the **passive voice**.

e.g. Speeches **are given** in award ceremonies. (*passive voice*)

We use 'has / have' + past participle to form sentences in the **present perfect tense**.

e.g. Dr Lai **has given** many speeches before. (*present perfect tense*)
