Grammar Explained



We put certain verbs and prepositions or adverbs together to form **phrasal verbs**. We use **phrasal verbs** to talk about people's actions. The meanings of phrasal verbs are often different from those of the verbs on their own.

find out get into get away give up
look for make up set off turn into

John	gets into	trouble quite often.
Did you	make up	the story about a monster?
Miss Wong	didn't look for	her missing shoe.
Mimi	won't give up	in the marathon.



Helpful Tips

We use 'set off' with the preposition 'for' to talk about starting a journey to a specific place.

e.g. The witches **set off for** Dark Dragon Mountain.

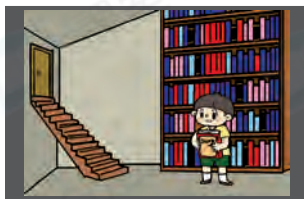
