Beginning

- How do the characters meet?
- What do they want to do?

Middle

- There is a problem
- What's wrong? → Tom goes to the wrong park!

Feelings

How do the characters feel?

Ending

- What may happen next?
- How do they solve the problem?

We can use **adjectives** to show the characters' feelings.

e.g. Chloe can't go to the beach. She is **upset**.

Practical Sentence Patterns

- a We can use ' **There** + **is / are** + **(number)** + **noun** ' to introduce something and tell the number of it.

Verb to 'be'

e.g. **There is** a mango. **Plural**
There are twelve mangoes.

We can use 'a / an' to replace 'one' when we talk about a singular noun.

- b We can use ' **There** + **is** + **no** ' or ' **There** + **are** + **no** + **'-s'** ' to tell that we cannot see something.

Uncountable

Countable : Plural

e.g. **There is** no rain. / **There are** no bananas.

- Ex. Fifi is in Monster Park. Look at the picture and circle the correct answers.

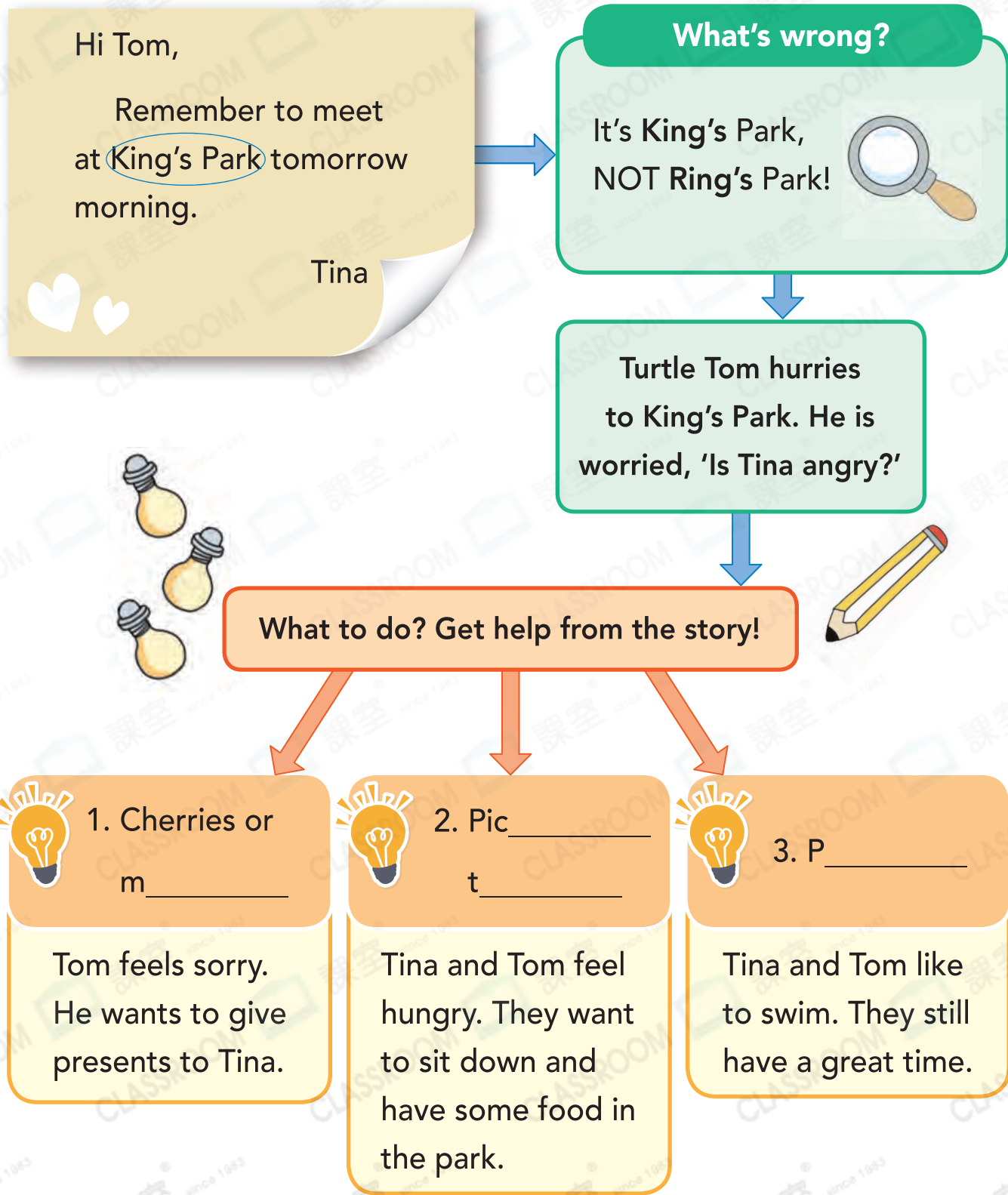
