- put it under a photo
- write only about the photo

USEFUL TIP

We can use the preposition 'in' to show where the thing(s) is / are.

e.g. These parrots are **in** a cage.

Practical Sentence Patterns

We can use '(a/an) **adjective** + **adjective** + **noun**' to tell more about how things look.

e.g. Chloe has **big eyes**. Chloe has **round eyes**.


→ Chloe has **big round eyes**.




We follow this order when we put two or more adjectives together:
size → form / shape → colour
✓ big long feet ✓ long grey hair
✓ big brown eyes

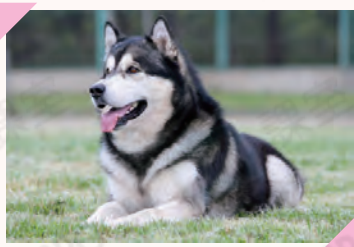
