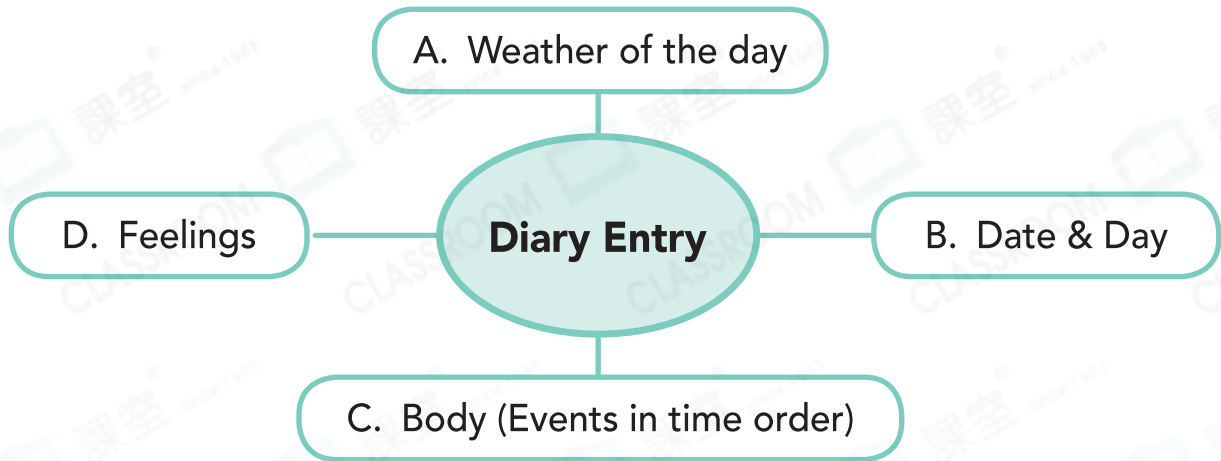

Banana Chocolate Mousse

Ingredients:

- 6 oz chocolate chips
- 1 teaspoon of sugar
- 2 cups of water
- 1 banana
- 3 eggs

Steps:

1. Place the chocolate chips in a bowl and heat it slowly over a pan of boiling water.
2. Stir the chocolate chips until they melt.
3. Move the pan away from the heat and let the chocolate cool down.
4. Separate the egg whites and egg yolks.
5. Add the egg yolks to the chocolate and stir.
6. Add the egg whites to the chocolate and stir.
7. Pour the chocolate mixture into three cups.
8. Cover each cup with plastic wrap and refrigerate for 2 hours.
9. Put a slice of banana on top of each cup.
