Mum : That's great! Thank you. See you soon!

### Amazing Vocabulary

There is not / isn't	<b>any</b>	water. (uncountable)
There are not / aren't		hotdogs. (countable)

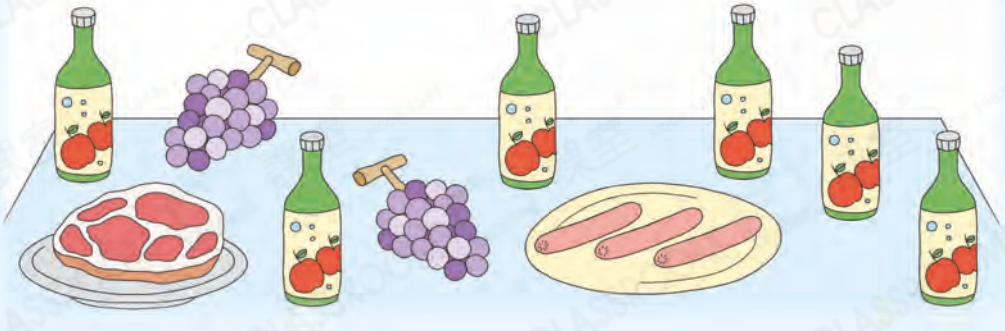
