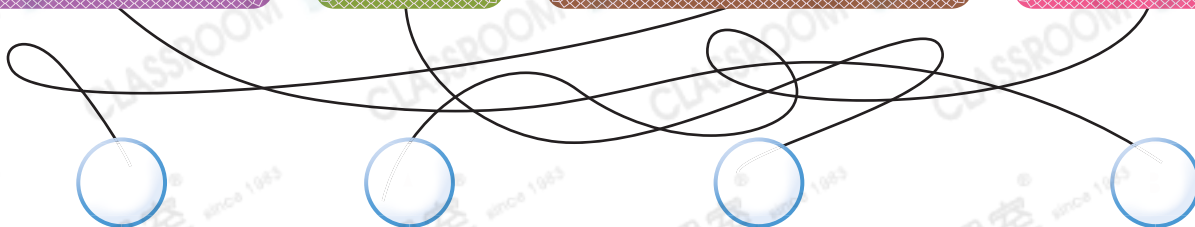

### Practical Sentence Patterns

**a** We can use 'too' to show and emphasise two positive ideas or feelings and 'either' to show and emphasise two negative ideas or feelings.

e.g. I enjoy playing tennis. Chloe enjoys playing it too.

e.g. Harry doesn't like apples. He doesn't like oranges either.

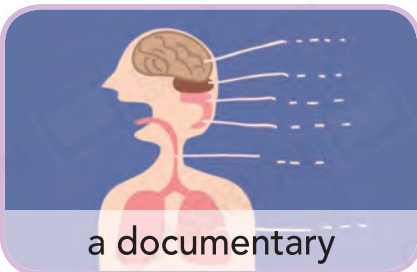

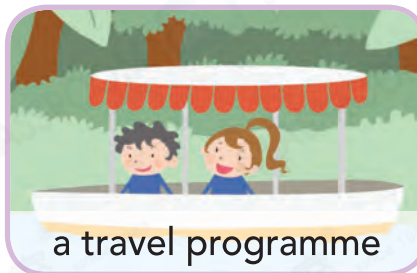
