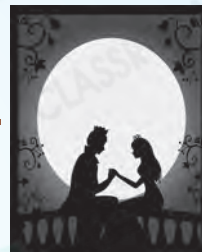

Banana Smoothie

Servings: 2

- A banana

Steps:

1. First peel the banana.
2. Then cut the banana into small pieces.
3. Next mix the banana, milk and ice cubes in a blender.
4. Finally pour the smoothie into a glass and add some decorations.

How to Use a Blender

1. Plug in the blender.
2. Put the ingredients, for example, banana, milk and ice cubes in the blender.
3. Close the lid and hold it tight.
4. Press the 'Mix' button to start blending.
5. Pour the mixture into a clean container.
6. Wash the blender thoroughly after use.
7. Enjoy your drink!
