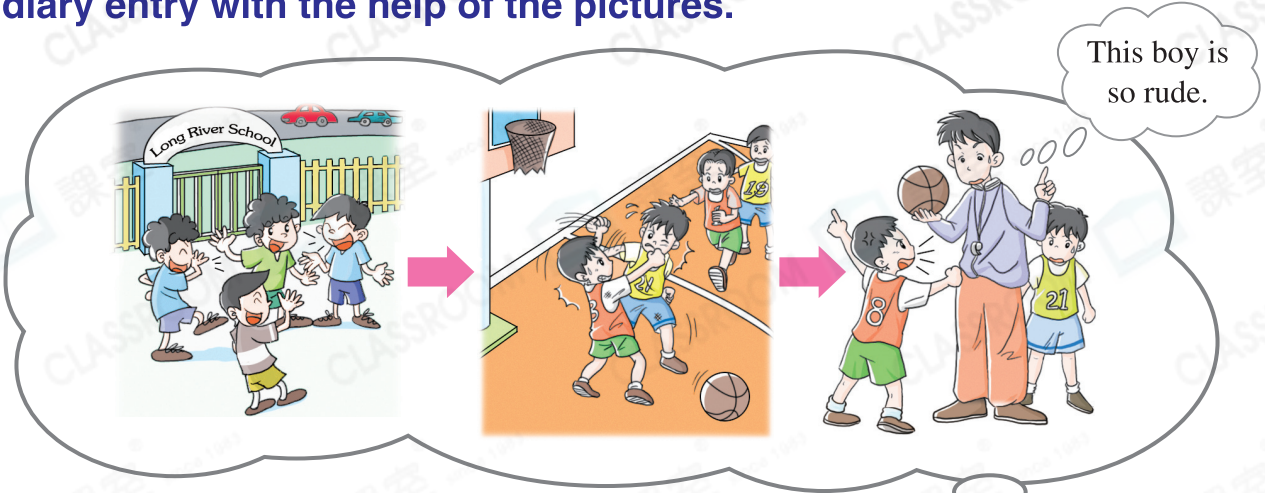
We usually add '-ly' to adjectives to form adverbs. Remember that if an adjective ends in 'i', we still add '-ly' to it instead of adding only '-y'.

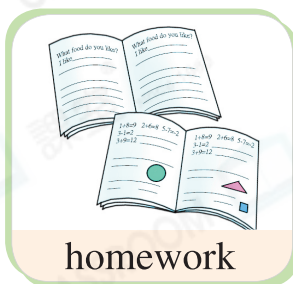
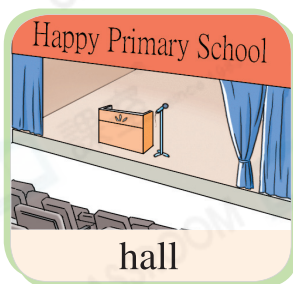
