Figure 1 Class 4D's favourite local attractions

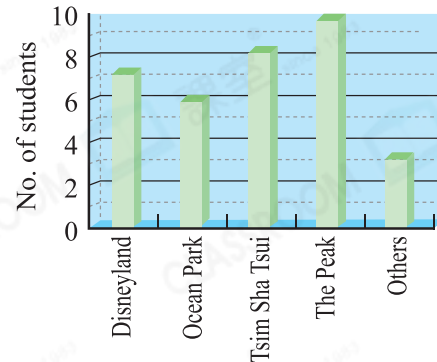
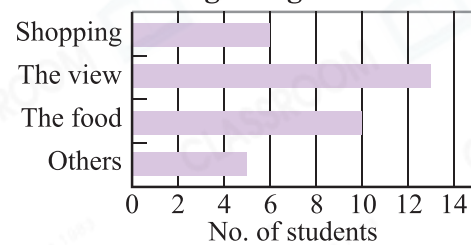


Figure 2 Reasons why students like Hong Kong

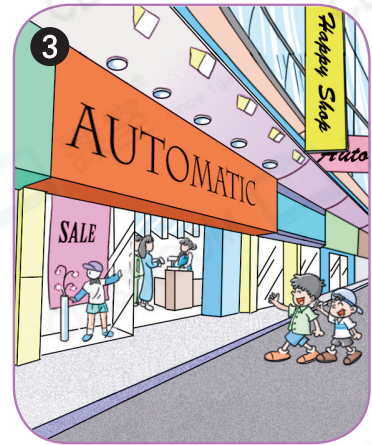

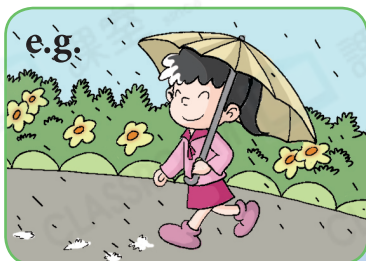

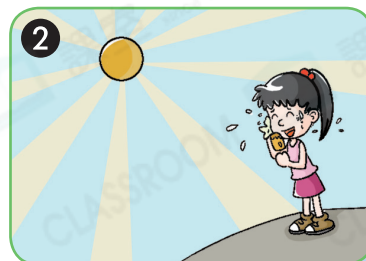
