Making a Colourful Sand Bottle

What you need:

1 bottle 1 spoon 1 funnel 1 chopstick

1 glue stick some coloured sand some seashells

How to make it:

- 1 Take away the bottle cap.
- 2 Put the funnel on top of the bottle.
- 3 Choose 3-5 colours you like for the sand.
- 4 Put the coloured sand in the funnel with a spoon. Put in the sand colour by colour.
- 5 Take away the funnel. Use a chopstick to shape the sand.
- 6 Put on the bottle cap.
- 7 Stick some seashells onto the bottle to make it beautiful. You can also try other small objects like shiny stars and stickers.
