

## In-text Grammar

We use the modal verb **'can'** to talk about things we are able to do.

e.g. What **can** you hear?

e.g. I **can** hear a song.

When we make a question with **'can'**, we put it before the subject.

✓ What **can** you see?

✗ What you **can** see?

When we use **'can'** in a statement, we put it after the subject.

We use the base form of the verb after **'can'**.

✓ He **can** dance.

✗ He **can** dances.
