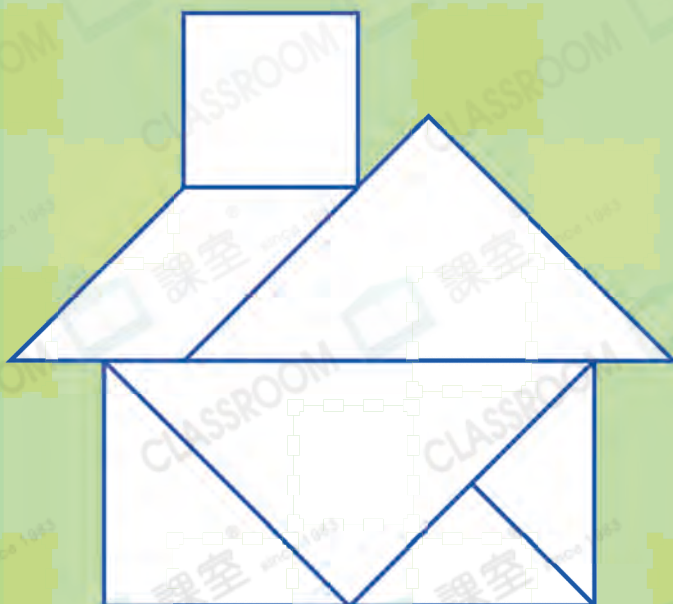

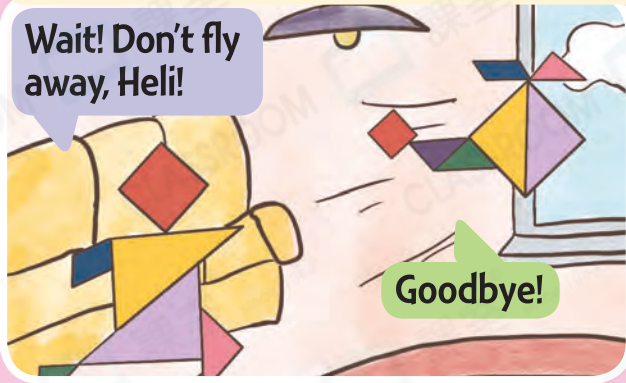

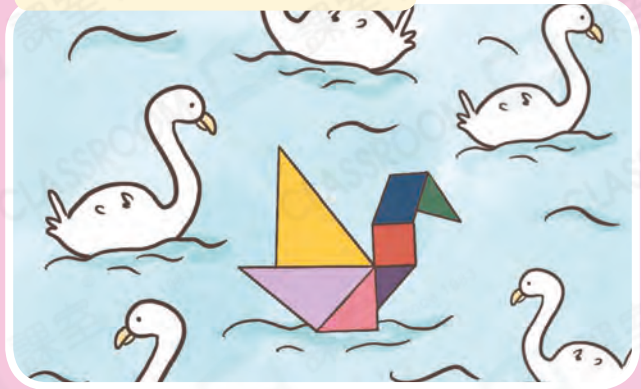


This is a tangram house.
