#### Poet

Tell who writes the poem

#### Stanza

- Look like a paragraph

In this poem, there are four stanzas and there are three lines in each stanza.

- Each stanza talks about one idea

#### Rhyming words

Include words that have the same ending sound, e.g. 'friend' and 'end'

#### Rhyming pattern

Have a pattern of rhymes at the end of each line

In this poem, the pattern is AAB  
CCD EEF GGH.
