Some questions test your ability to collect information from different parts of the text and then choose the correct option. There are three steps to answering such questions:

- 1 Circle the keywords in the question and options.
- 2 Read the whole text and highlight the parts that are related to the keywords.
- 3 See which option matches the highlighted parts in the text.

### Give it a try!

- e.g.** Chris wants to join the birthday party, he needs to \_\_\_\_\_.
- A. go to Causeway Bay on 8<sup>th</sup> November
  - B. send Judy an e-mail
  - C. dress up as a prince
  - D. bring some snacks to the party

You can get information from different parts of the invitation card to find out the answer. Option A is false because the **date** of the party is **11<sup>th</sup> November**. According to the **RSVP**, people have to **send an e-mail to Rachael** if they want to join the party so option B is false. Option D is also false because one of the **great things about the party** is the **tasty food**. People don't have to bring any food to the party. Option C is the correct answer because people have to **dress up** for the party.
