What you need:

- 1 banana
- 3 scoops of ice cream (vanilla, chocolate and strawberry)
- 2 tablespoons of chocolate syrup
- some whipped cream

Serving: 1
Time needed: 10 mins

How to make it:

1. First, peel the banana. Split it into two pieces.
2. Next, put the ice cream in between the two banana pieces.
3. Then, top the ice cream with some whipped cream.
4. Finally, add some chocolate syrup on top of the whole banana split.

Tip: Wait for 2-3 minutes after taking out the ice cream from the freezer to let the ice cream melt a little. Then, this is the best time to scoop it!
