Monthly Activities Review

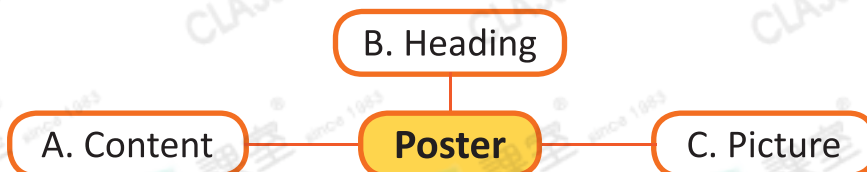
On the first Saturday of May, Ms Wong, Mr Johnson and 30 volunteers visited True Light Old People's Home.
