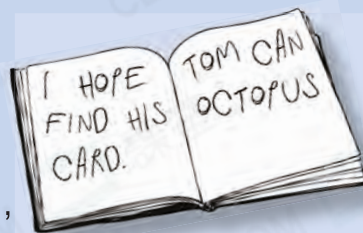


Hailey is reading the back cover of a storybook.
