

## In-text Grammar

We use **'Which would you like'** to ask people what they want politely when we are giving them a number of choices to choose from. We use **'or'** to link the choices.

**e.g.** Which would you like, chicken breast sandwich **or** Caesar salad?

I'd like tuna.

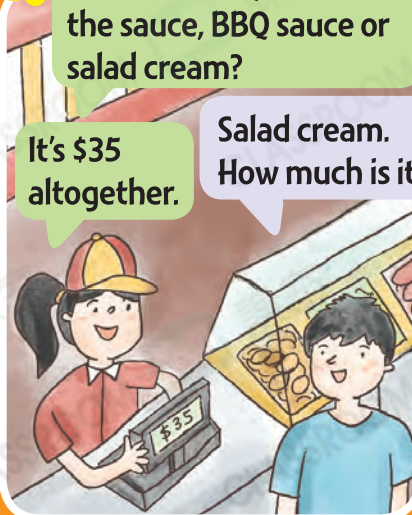
