Mr Tomato's Organic Farm

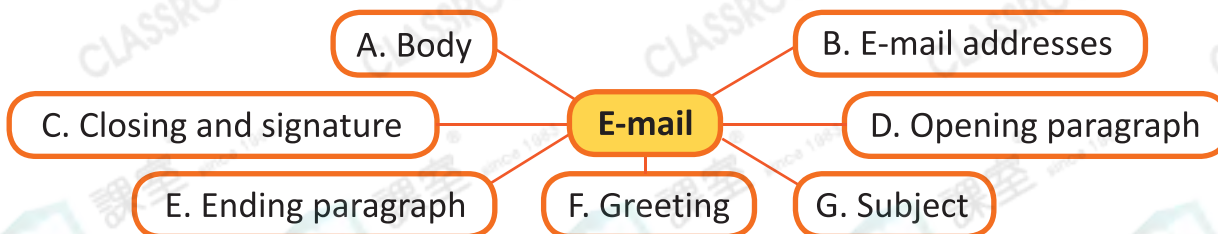
