23rd June (Saturday)



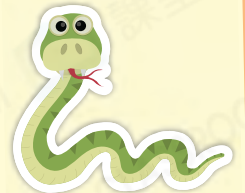
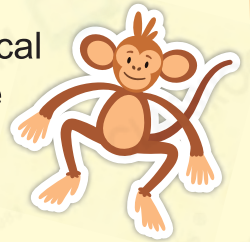
Sunny
