Want to have a special weekend? Why not go camping? Consider Pui O Campsite your next destination!

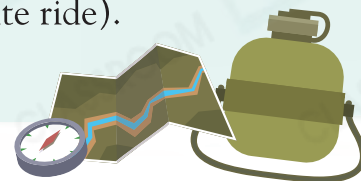
