



Reading Skill: Analysing and integrating points

Learn together!

Some questions test your ability to gather information from different parts of the text and to determine which option is correct after careful consideration. There are three steps to answering such questions:

- 1** Underline the keywords in the question and options.
- 2** Skim through the text and highlight the parts that are relevant to the question and options.
- 3** Examine the highlighted parts and work out the relationship among them to see which option matches the context.

Learn more!

Pay attention that the wording of the options is usually different from that of the information provided in the text.

e.g. Sandy enjoys shopping very much. She always buys new clothes and shoes.
= Sandy is a shopaholic.

Give it a try!

- e.g.** Adrian wants to join the race. He needs to _____ before the race. (Choose more than one answer.)
- A. practise more and train himself hard
 - B. fill in a printed entry form and mail it to HKSA by 28th August
 - C. pay the entry fee in cash
 - D. attend a swimming test held by HKSA

This question asks about the requirements for taking part in the race. You can find out the answers by looking for information from different parts of the poster. Option A is correct. You can find the related information in the **opening paragraph**. There is a need for Adrian to practise and train more because the race is a **'physically demanding event'**. Option D is also correct. You can find the information in the part **'Each participant must:'**. To enter the race, each participant must pass the swimming test organised by HKSA beforehand. Options B and C are incorrect. You can pay attention to the **'Entry procedure'** in the part **'Race information:'**. Every participant needs to pay the entry fee and submit the entry form online.
