Mother's Day

No Bake Chocolate Cake

(4 servings)



Mother's Day is coming. Why not make a cake for Mum by yourself? It's easy and you don't even need an oven!

Ingredients:

- 45 g butter
- 240 g milk chocolate
- 200 g cream cheese
- 200 g digestive biscuits
- 110 g sugar
- 240 ml whipping cream
- 120 ml chocolate syrup
- some candies

Steps:

- 1 Melt the butter and sugar together.
- 2 Crush the biscuits and add them into the mixture.
- 3 Press the mixture into a cake tin to make the biscuit base. Chill it in the fridge.
- 4 Whip the cream cheese and whipping cream separately.
- 5 Melt the milk chocolate and mix it with the cream cheese and whipping cream.
- 6 Pour the mixture on top of the biscuit base.
- 7 Put the cake in the fridge for two hours before taking it out. Decorate it with candies and chocolate syrup.
