Bus drivers' long working hours causes 50 injuries

A terrible bus crash occurred at a crossroad in Mong Kok at 8 pm yesterday.

A 68X double-decker could not slow down in time when it tried to avoid hitting a taxi in front of it. It then drove onto a pavement by mistake and crashed into a bus stop, leaving 50 people injured. Five ambulances and two fire engines were

called to the scene. The bus driver was later arrested for 'causing injury by dangerous driving'.

Some passengers reported that before the accident, the bus driver fell asleep at one point and even drove through a red light. They felt nervous because they knew that something bad was going to happen.

People blamed bus drivers' long working hours for causing the accident. 'How could the driver be so careless? Did he forget that there were more than a hundred of us on the bus?' Mr Wong, the passenger who called the police, complained. As a result, the bus company is urged to review bus drivers' work shifts as soon as possible.
