



In-text Grammar

We use **reflexive pronouns** when the subject and object of a sentence are the same.

e.g. Gary bought **himself** a large cake on his birthday.

e.g. 'Behave **yourselves**,' Mum told Ann and me.

Use 'yourself' when referring to one person while 'yourselves' for two or more people.
