Many dogs lost their homes because their owners **abandoned** them. Our volunteer teams rescue, look after and rehome the homeless dogs. To ensure they can get enough exercise and grow healthily, our volunteers walk them in nearby parks every day. At the same time, we organise talks at different schools regularly to teach children how to get close to dogs in the right way.
