### Black-faced Spoonbill

The habitat of Black-faced Spoonbills is threatened by human activities. They are now considered globally endangered, with a small world population of about 4,000. Preserving their breeding areas and ensuring they have enough food are therefore very important.



### Incense Tree

Incense trees' fragrant wood can be used to make perfume and medicine. Poachers therefore chop them down and sell the wood for high prices in the black market. As a result, illegal logging has caused incense trees to become close to extinction. They are currently listed as vulnerable.
