

Cindy is reading some messages from her friends.

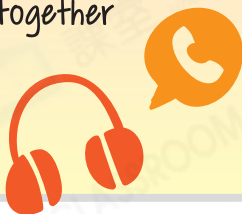
Dear Cindy,
