What colour is the T-shirt?
are the socks?

It is blue and green.
They are black and white.

We use the following words to talk about different colours.

black 	blue 	brown 	green 	orange 
pink 	red 	white 	yellow 	

Grammar Tip

Do not add the word 'colour' after a colour word.
e.g. ✓ It is red.
✗ It is red colour.

We can put singular, plural or uncountable nouns after **possessive adjectives**.

e.g. her skirt, his boots, my hair



Common Errors

✓ **His** shoes are blue.

✗ **He** shoes are blue.

- Look at Max. **It / Its** has a ball. **It / Its** ball is big.
- Lucy, how are you? I like **you / your** pink cap!
