We ask questions for different information in different ways.

Ask about names, classes, activities, colours and abilities:

What

is your name?
class are you in?
are you doing?
colour is the doll?

What

can

a cat do?
you see?



Grammar Tip

Pay attention that questions start with 'Can', 'Is this / Is that' and 'Are these / Are those' are yes-no questions.

Ask about abilities:

Can birds fly?

Ask about locations:

Where are the boys?

Ask about ages:

How old are you?

Ask about numbers:

How many birds are there?

Ask about people, animal(s) or thing(s):

Is this

a monkey?

Is that

Are these

teddy bears?
