Grammar Notes

It has / They have **Adjectives**

It has three **big** eyes!

They have **long** ears **and** **long** tails!



We can use 'It has' or 'They have' to talk about the body part(s) of the animal(s). We can also use different **adjectives** to describe the body part(s).



This is a monkey.

It has **long** arms.
a **small** head.



These are elephants.

They have **big** ears.

Grammar Tip

We use 'It has' for one animal. We use 'They have' for two or more animals.

We use 'and' to link two **adjectives** to describe the thing(s), person(s) or animal(s).

A giraffe is	tall	and	thin.
Hamsters are	short	and	fat.

Grammar Tip

We can put one or more adjectives after 'is' or 'are' to talk about how an animal looks. Remember we cannot use 'and' to link two opposite adjectives.

e.g. ✗ fat and thin



Common Errors

✓ It **has** long legs.

✗ It **is** long legs.

✓ It **is** small and cute.

✗ It **has** small and cute.

- It has / It is short legs.
- The bear has / bear is big and fat.

Grammar Tip

We usually put an adjective (e.g. short) before a noun (e.g. legs) to talk about what body part(s) the animal(s) has / have.

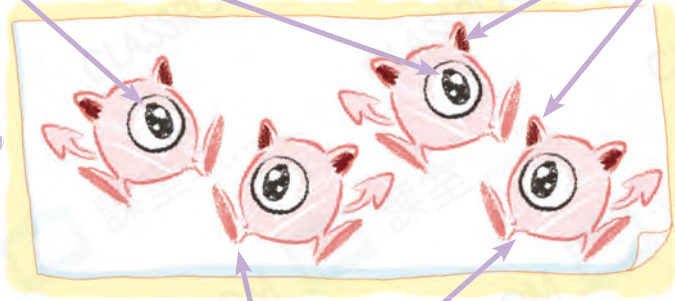
