Grammar Notes

Yes-no Questions VS Wh-Questions

Do not mix up **yes-no questions** and **wh-questions**. A **yes-no question** needs a yes or a no answer. We can use **'Do / Does'** or **'Is there'** to ask **yes-no questions**.

Does	she have any pens?	Yes, she does. / No, she doesn't.
Is there	a library?	Yes, there is. / No, there isn't.

Wh-questions begin with **wh-words**. We use **wh-questions** to ask for different kinds of information.

Where	is the park?	It is near the river.	ask about locations
What	is your name?	My name is Jasper.	ask about things
Who	is running?	My cousin is running.	ask about people



Common Errors

- ✓ Do you like to go cycling? **Yes, I do.**
- ✗ Where do you go cycling? **No, I don't.**

Grammar Tip

Don't answer a **wh-question** with **'Yes'** or **'No'**.

- Do you like to eat hamburgers? **Yes, I do. / I like to eat hamburgers.**
- Where is the cinema? **Yes, there is. / It is behind the cafe.**
