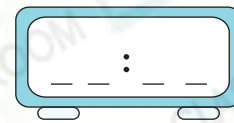
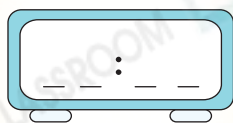

✓ He reads **at** night. ✗ He reads at **the** night.

- Ellie likes to listen to music **at / at the** night.
- At seven **at / at the** night, we have dinner.
