## Grammar Notes

### Question Word: Which

Which festival do you like most?

I like the Cheung Chau Bun Festival most.

What do you do at this festival?

I eat a lot of buns.

We use the question word 'Which' to ask about what people like most.

Which festival do you like most?

I like Chinese New Year most.

### Grammar Tip

We usually put a singular noun after 'Which'.

## Simple Present Tense 3

We use the **simple present tense** to ask and talk about what to do at different festivals. We add **'-s'** or **'-es'** to the verbs after the third-person singular subjects such as 'he' and 'she'.

What	<b>do</b>	you / we / they	<b>do</b>	at Christmas?
	<b>does</b>	he / she		



We use 'at' with festivals.

I / We / They	<b>play</b>	party games	at Christmas.
He / She	<b>plays</b>		

I / We / They	<b>do not / don't go</b>	on an egg hunt at Easter.
He / She	<b>does not / doesn't go</b>	



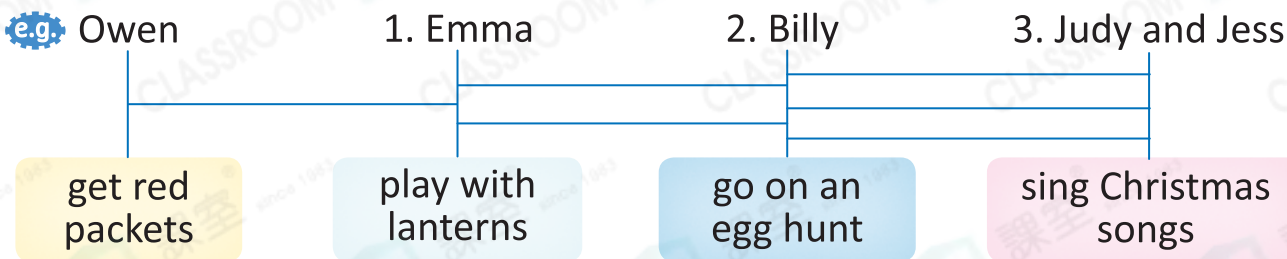
Common Errors

✓ Ian and Zoe **eat** candies. ✗ Ian and Zoe **eats** candies.

- Amy and Leo **eat / eats** mooncakes at the Mid-Autumn Festival.
- Emma **see / sees** the Christmas lights at Christmas.
