Prepositions of Direction: up / down



Okay, Max. Now, let's climb **up** the hill. Then, we go **down** the stairs. After that, we walk **from** the stairs **to** the campfire.

We use the prepositions of direction **'up'** and **'down'** to talk about directions of how someone or something moves.

Max climbs **up** the stairs.
Max goes **down** the stairs.

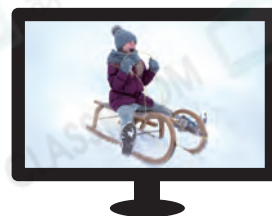

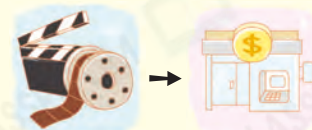


Prepositions of Direction: from / to



We use the prepositions of direction **'from'** and **'to'** to talk about the place where someone or something starts to move to, and where someone or something goes.

Dad	walks	from	the cinema	to	the bank.
		to	the bank	from	the cinema.



We do not always use **'from'** and **'to'** together.

He	is going	to	school now.
She	is coming	from	home now.

Grammar Tip

We seldom put the article 'the' before 'school' and 'home'.



Common Errors

- ✓ He comes home **from** school.
- ✗ He comes home **form** school.

- I walk **form / from** the library to the music room.
- The plane flies **from / form** Hong Kong to Australia.

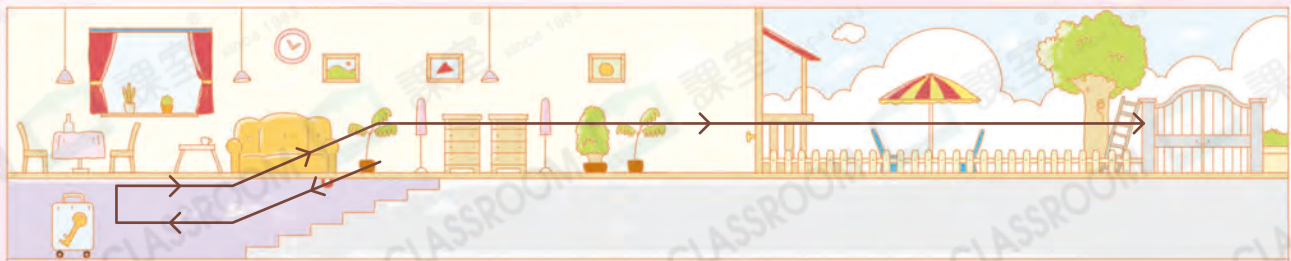
