Modal Verb: can

What are you doing, Jasper?



I **cannot** use the Internet because there is no wi-fi.

It's okay. You **can** use my phone...

We use the modal verb '**can**' to talk about actions that it is possible to do. We use '**cannot / can't**' to talk about actions that it is impossible to do. We use the base form of verbs after '**can**' and '**cannot / can't**'.

Mum **can** go shopping at the mall tonight.

She **cannot / can't** shop there after it closes at 10 p.m.

Grammar Notes

Modal Verb: must

We use the modal verb **'must'** to talk about actions that it is necessary to do. We use **'must not / mustn't'** to talk about actions that are not allowed. We often use **'must'** and **'must not / mustn't'** to talk about rules. We use the base form of verbs after **'must'** and **'must not / mustn't'**.

We	must	keep quiet in the library.
You	must not / mustn't	talk loudly on the phone.



Common Errors

- ✓ He **mustn't be** late for school.
- ✗ He **mustn't is** late for school.

- Ellie **must arrive / arrives** at school before half past eight.
- Jasper **mustn't be / is** naughty at school.
- Students **must are / be** punctual for all lessons.
