Adverbs of Sequence

How do we set up a tent?

It's easy! **First**, take out the tent. **Then**, give it to Lucas. **After that**, he will set it up. **Finally**, the tent is done!

Jasper, you're so lazy!



We use **adverbs of sequence** to show the time order of actions. We usually put **adverbs of sequence** at the beginning of sentences. We put a comma after an **adverb of sequence** to link it with the action.

First ,	take the MTR to Diamond Hill Station.
Next ,	walk to the bus terminal.
Then ,	take the bus to Wong Shek Pier.
After that ,	take the ferry to Wan Chai Pier.
Finally ,	take a 5-minute walk on the stony path to the campsite.

Grammar Tip

'Next', 'then' and 'after that' are similar in meanings, and we can use them in any order.

Grammar Tip

We usually use **imperatives** after adverbs of sequence to give orders or instructions. It means that we use the **base form of verbs** to talk about the actions.

Common Errors

- ✓ First, take out your compass.
- ✗ First take out your compass.
- ✗ First, takes out your compass.
