### different / the same

Look! Master Chef and I made **the same** dish. Come and try it, Jasper!



I think the dishes have **different** tastes.

We use **'different'** to talk about people or things that are not the same.

Jasper and Ellie like watching **different** cartoons.

We use **'the same'** to talk about things that are exactly like each other.

Jasper and his best friend are **the same** age.

### Grammar Tip

Remember to use **plural nouns** after 'different'.

## Reciprocal Pronoun: each other



We use the reciprocal pronoun **'each other'** to talk about each person in a group doing the same thing to the other person. We mostly use it with a group of two people. We put the reciprocal pronoun **'each other'** after verbs or verbs with prepositions.

Ellie and Jasper	are pointing at	<b>each other.</b>
Mum and Dad	care about	



We can use **'each other'** to talk about animals too.

Max and the kitten	get along with	<b>each other.</b>
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### Common Errors

✓ We care about **each other.**      ✗ We care about **each others.**

- Mum and Dad listen to **each other / each others.**
- Jasper and Dan don't chat with **each other / each others** in class.
